Being mindful of family and friends and how food brings people together, guests also received a complete and complementary Thanksgiving meal to prepare for their loved ones.

Thanks to our partners Vineyard Cincinnati Church and 4 Corners Church, who donated the food items needed to serve 205 families and rallied to fill 222 volunteer roles needed to make this event a success.
