

COVID IMPACT

We experienced a difficult year in 2020, as did many other churches. In March of 2020, when the impact of Covid began to hit and we had to quickly pivot to online church, revenue for the church dropped 16%, which continued through the remainder of the year. A principle of sound biblical stewardship led the senior leadership team to downsize staffing levels commensurate with the change in attendance and giving. No matter what the level of giving, the Vineyard always maintains this principle of healthy stewardship to protect the church's ability to serve the community.

FUTURE LOOK

With a new lead pastor, the trends of giving and generosity are showing signs of improvement which will allow ministry to move forward with encouragement into 2021!

Every year, VCC engages an independent accounting firm to perform an audit regarding our financial recordkeeping. This fiscal year, once again we received an unmodified (clean) audit opinion, which is the highest "grade" possible!
