



Dear Mission Team Guest,

We know you're passionate and eager to serve orphaned and vulnerable children. We are grateful for your commitment and the significant investment you are making to come on a mission trip. We are committed to doing everything in our power to keep the mission guests, staff, and children we serve healthy and safe. We can't wait to see you!

Here are some things we ask of you as you prepare to visit a Back2Back site:

- Please avoid contact with individuals with COVID-19 or suspected COVID-19 for at least two weeks prior to your travel date.
- Provide a negative COVID-19 test dated within 7 days of your visit, proof of vaccination or proof of recovery.
- Complete a final symptom check and temperature screening 24 hours prior to travel.
- Review the following site for your country's travel [requirements](#) on a regular basis.

During your trip, we will have several measures in place to ensure everyone's health and safety. Here's what you can expect:

- Your team may be smaller. We will host between 5-13 people on a team.
- Your trip will be shorter. Your trip will be a maximum of 5 days in length.
- Your team will be assigned 1-2 staff members for your entire stay.
- You will be asked to complete a brief daily health screening (temperature and symptom check).
- You will be asked to wear a mask while indoors and while outside if not able to maintain 6 feet distance and follow any additional country mask guidelines.
- Your interactions with children will be limited to outdoor activities and we will work together to maintain safe distance.
- Back2Back staff will provide cleaning supplies for your use and work with you to ensure surfaces are cleaned daily.
- Back2Back will maintain a minimum of 24 hours between teams in order to maintain sanitary conditions and deep clean the facilities.
- The team leader will identify a male and female adult leader who will serve as caretaker in the event of a quarantine of an individual/individuals.

If, in the unfortunate event you or someone on your mission team gets sick, here's what we will ask of you and your team. First, Back2Back staff will:

- Arrange for prompt COVID-19 testing for you and ask you to cover the cost.
- Arrange and provide housing, meals and other required needs to quarantine.
- Assist you in remaining quarantined until you receive a negative test result.
- Assist exposed team members to appropriately quarantine.

In the event of a positive COVID-19 test, it is recommended that this person remain in quarantine for 10 days from onset of illness prior to traveling back to the U.S.

We will do everything in our power to prepare to receive mission guests and accommodate you while you visit our sites. We can't wait to see you soon! **We're all in this together and we are grateful for your support.**

We are committed to following the latest CDC ([cdc.gov](https://www.cdc.gov)) guidelines in order to keep everyone safe and healthy. While we all hope to return to normalcy soon, the following checklists have been created with guidelines in mind for 2021 trips.

Please initial the following and email a PDF of this form the day before your trip to missiontrip@back2back.org.

- I am between the ages of 8 and 64.
- I have not been in contact with individuals with COVID-19 or suspected COVID-19 for the past 14 days.
- I have completed the symptom survey and confirm I do not have any symptoms of COVID-19 prior to leaving.
- I have provided a negative COVID-19 test dated within 7 days of your visit, proof of vaccination or recovery.
- I do not have chronic kidney disease or two of the following conditions including asthma, diabetes, coronary artery disease, history of stroke, or COPD. (See CDC potential health risks)
- I agree to be tested and quarantined if I show any symptoms of COVID-19, including fever of 100° or higher, loss of smell or taste, or shortness of breath.
- I understand it is my responsibility to cover the cost of COVID-19 testing.
