...expanded on last year's capital improvements in our food pantry and clothing stores by providing an elevated shopping experience for our guests that communicates the dignity and worth God sees in His people.

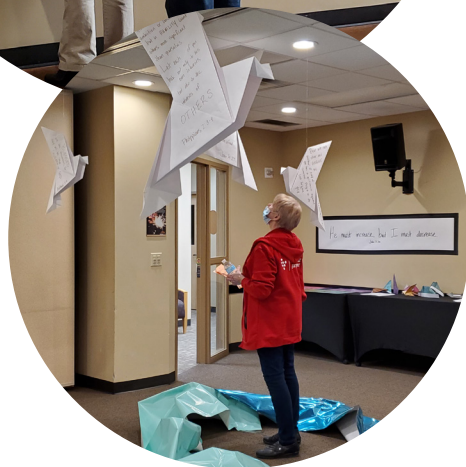
...hosted a Grand Re-Opening to invite the community to see the redesigned stores and highlight services that we provide through an interactive passport stamp gathering activity.

PRAYER...

In March, we transformed our classrooms into the "Renew Prayer Experience", the first ever Healing Center interactive prayer experience where we invited guests to participate in prayer activities designed to help listen to and hear from God.

130 people had Extended Prayer appointments, meeting with our prayer partners for a deeper experience of seeking God for healing, understanding, and peace.

Every session we are open for services, prayer partners are ready to **engage** by praying with or for you about any spiritual needs you have.



ESOL/GED...

We continue our proud partnership with Cincinnati Public Schools to provide guests the opportunity to learn English for Speakers of Other Languages or earn their High School Diploma or GED.

ESOL classes saw **450 attendees**
4 of those ESOL students moved on to
earn their GED.

Through our Thrive program participants receive mentoring, group support, career and money coaching and individualized prayer as they work toward taking measurable and meaningful steps that move them from crisis to stability to THRIVING.

When you let community into your situation when you are at your most vulnerable place in life, it can bring about a sense of revival, because all of these people can come love on you at the same time.

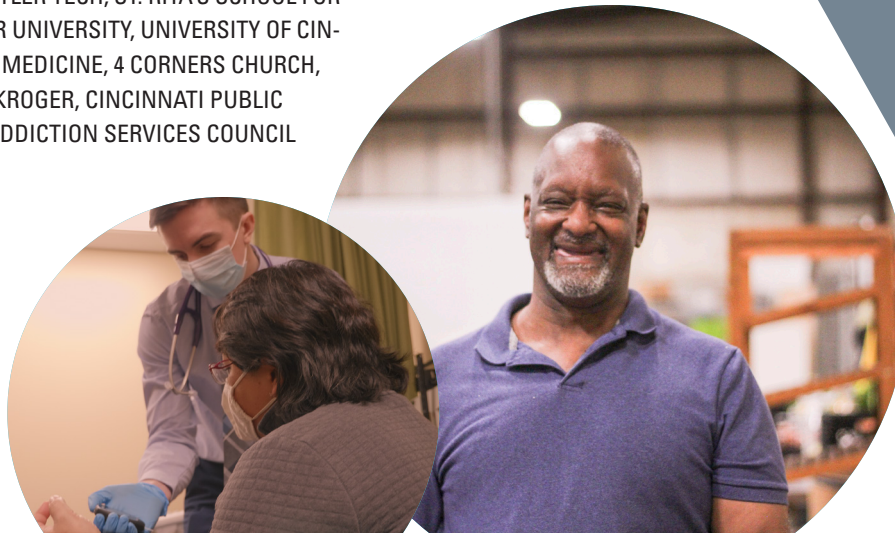
