In March, we transformed our classrooms into the "Renew Prayer Experience", the first ever Healing Center interactive prayer experience where we invited guests to participate in prayer activities designed to help listen to and hear from God.

**130 people** had Extended Prayer appointments, meeting with our prayer partners for a deeper experience of seeking God for healing, understanding, and peace.
