MAKING ROOM FOR GOD'S NEXT STEP

Leigh Lutz is a House Group leader who mentors high school girls. Here's how Leigh got started.

It never once occurred to me to work with high school students. I honestly didn't think I had the patience for it and had no desire to find out if I was wrong. About 18 months ago, Eric Chesney (the Life Groups Pastor) approached me after a service and asked if I had any margin in my life. I said "No." I was already involved in several ministries at the Vineyard and also in my community.

Eric smiled and patiently waited for the Lord to slow me down. He felt God had impressed upon him that I would be a good fit to work with high school girls. I agreed to observe but also told him that if the Lord wanted me there I would have to back away from some other serving roles as I was at max capacity.

As I entered the house in West Chester for the first time, I did not have high hopes. I felt like I was walking into the first day of high school not thinking I would fit in. I foolishly thought I was too old to be taken seriously and fully expected to leave that night telling Eric it was not where I should be. But as I sat there with those girls, I realized, more than anything, I wanted to be where God is.

I want to be a witness and a participant to where He is working. And He is most definitely working there. I immediately adjusted my schedule and have been there joyfully ever since. I cannot believe that the Lord would allow me to share in this. And I almost missed it because I doubted that as the Scriptures say in Ephesians 3:20-21 that God can do immeasurably more that all we ask or imagine,
