ALPHA :: *Fall 2019*

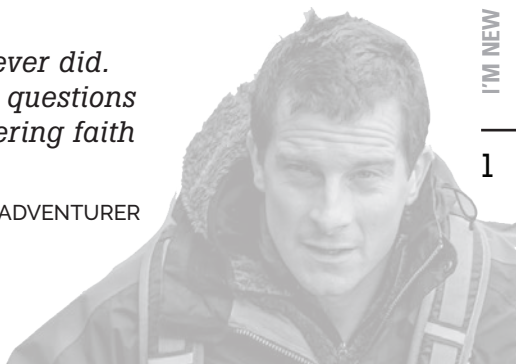

MEN'S HEALTHY SEXUALITY (MHS) :: Sept. 16 – Dec. 16



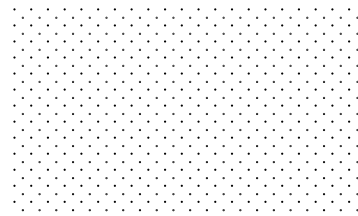

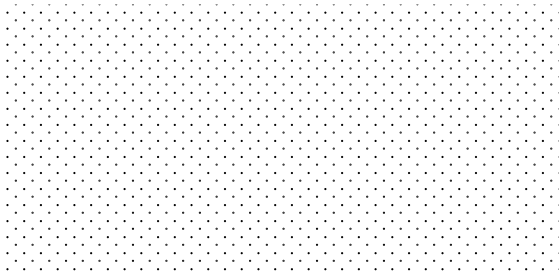

MAKING A BIG CHURCH FEEL SMALL

Meet Stephanie Estridge, a Team Leader in Momentum 56. We asked Stephanie a few questions about why she serves in Momentum.

How did you start serving in Momentum 56?

I actually started serving shortly after my son was born. I attended a Vineyard Kids Volunteer Orientation looking to plug in to keep myself accountable and develop relationships with other Christians. I'd attended the Vineyard for 7 years at that time, and really didn't know anyone. I went to church with my family and that was it. I was looking for growth, and I have found that in serving for Momentum 56!



Has serving in Momentum helped you feel more connected?

It's funny actually because I didn't feel connected at all before serving in Momentum 56. I remember feeling overwhelmed with "big church." Growing up I attended a small church and had amazing friendships and mentors.

Before attending the Vineyard Kids Volunteer Orientation I thought about looking for another church that gave me that "small church" feeling that I so longed for. I felt like God was telling me I was exactly where I was meant to be. I trusted Him, and when I heard about the first Vineyard Kids Orientation meeting after service I felt the Holy Spirit pushing me to check it out.
