

**Dates:** October 17–18, 2020

**Bible Passage:** God is the One True God (Exodus 19–20)

**Activity 1 Supplies:** “tablet” pictures, markers

**Activity 2 Supplies:** Music CD, player

*Children respond to what the Holy Spirit is teaching them as they reflect on the day's portion of The Big God Story, engage in relationship, and create meaningful pieces of art individually or together.*

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## **Reflect: God is the One True God**

*Encourage the child to open their Bible to the book of Exodus, chapter 7.*

### **Questions for Kids**

- **Why did God deliver His people from slavery?** Exodus 7:16
- **How did God appear on the mountain?** Exodus 19:16, 18
- **Why did God give His people the Ten Commandments, and what are some of them?** Exodus 20
- **How can we love God? How can we love others?**

## **Engage:**

### **Activity 1: Stone Tablets**

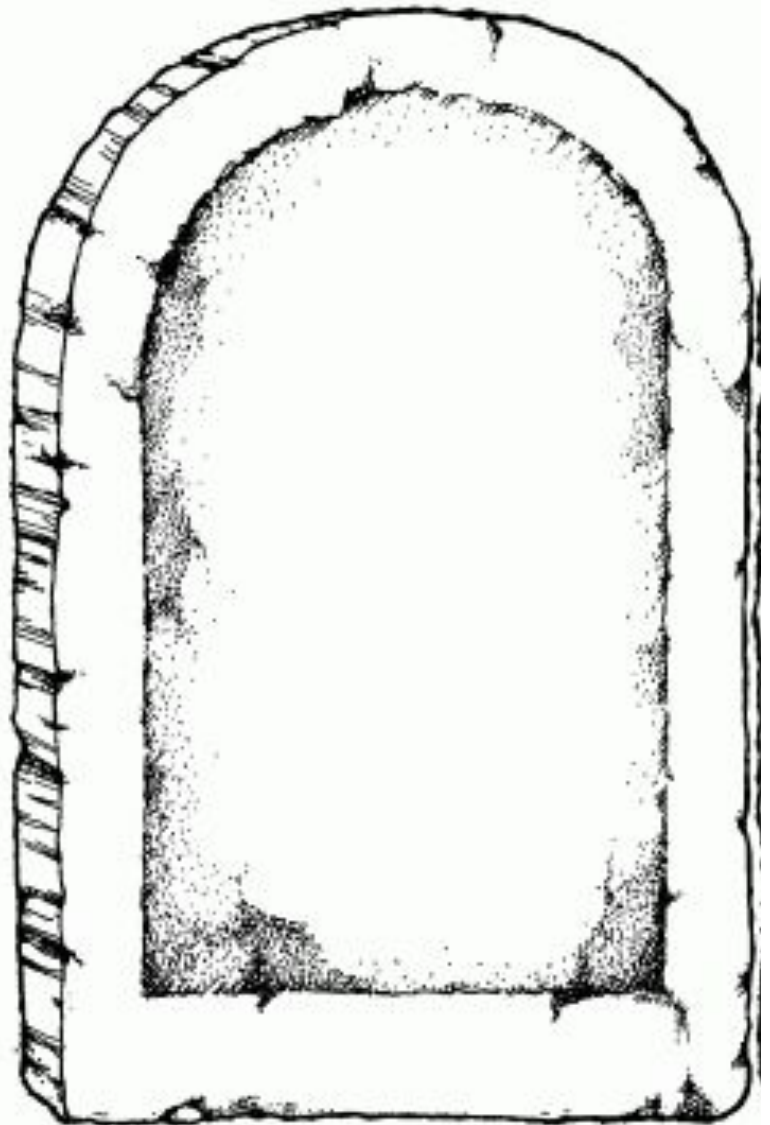
**SUPPLIES:** “tablet” pictures, markers

**By giving the Israelites the Ten Commandments, God showed His people how to follow Him and worship Him as the one true God. How can we worship Him as the one true God each day of our lives? Give the child a few moments to think about this question.**

**Later in The Big God Story, God gave Moses the Ten Commandments on tablets of stone (Exodus 24:12). Today we can respond to God on our own “stone tablets.”**

*Give the child the tablet print out (or draw one on a piece of paper) and have them draw a picture or write words that represent their thoughts about worshipping God as the one true God on the tablet.*

*For example, a child might draw a heart or write “His.”*



## Activity 2 Memory Verse Freeze Dance

**SUPPLIES:** *Music CD, player*

Today, we are going to play a game called *Freeze Dance* to help you memorize our verse.

Let's spread out around the room making sure to not be too close to something because you will need room to dance! I will start the music and we will dance until the song stops. If I catch you moving after the music you will have to say the memory verse before you can rejoin the dance party.

*Put the CD in the CD player and turn the music on. Allow the child to dance and then hit pause. Have anyone who is still dancing stop and say the verse. Then start the music again. Take turns with the child starting and stopping the music and you say the verse.*

### **Memory Verse:**

**Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;  
in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.  
Proverbs 3:5–6**

### **Bless:**

*Open a Bible and read Romans 5:1–2:*
