

Lives Impacted

About six years ago a friend invited me to come to the Vineyard. Soon after my first visit I gave my life to Jesus and started to experience a progressive change in my life. I stopped drinking & smoking, and started to do what I thought God wanted me to do: pray, read the Bible, attend church regularly, and tithe—with a joyful heart.

My faith started to be tested when I was diagnosed with arthritis, and just when things were getting better I was diagnosed with colon cancer. After surgery, the doctor gave me a 25% chance to live if I did chemotherapy. I spent 20 years of savings for a house to pay for my medical treatments.

IN ALL THESE TRIALS, I LEARNED TO HAVE FAITH IN GOD NO MATTER WHAT...

God showed up through the generous help of my employer, and through people who gave us gift cards and food. The Hispanic Ministry here also prayed that God was going to heal me, even though my chances were low.

By the glory of God, a year ago the doctor declared me cancer-free! In all these trials, I learned to have faith in God no matter what and to be faithful with my giving.

I was invited to the Vineyard and started attending regularly—but it took me a little bit because my Baptist background is wearing skirts and

a hat to church, so it was very different for me. But I continued to come.

I came over to the Healing Center again during an open house, and it was like the sky opened up and light shone bright on me. I couldn't believe what the church did for the community. I couldn't believe that they babysat your child while you were getting computer classes and money coaching and job coaching. It was amazing. That day I knew that I WILL be a part of it. My friend called me and invited me to the volunteer class, so I did, and within a week I was already volunteering.

I COULDN'T BELIEVE WHAT THE CHURCH DID FOR THE COMMUNITY.

It changed me so much that I decided to go back to school to find out how I can better help people, and I'm going for my bachelor's in social work.

I'm here to serve, and I want that for everybody.

I'm in 7th grade. We always went to church so it just seemed normal to me, but I never focused in or dug deep on what it meant to me personally. And it finally got to the point where I said "Lord, if you're real...show me." And when I asked that, it's like this peace came over me.

And then things began to change. My grandfather gave me two of his guitars and this little amp. And soon after that the light bulb kinda went off and I discovered my passion in music.

IT FINALLY GOT TO THE POINT WHERE I SAID "LORD, IF YOU'RE REAL...SHOW ME".

Now, as soon as I start to play something, there's a sort of connection that springs out of nowhere between me and the Lord. I used to just play by and for myself and I'd never publicly proclaimed that "I follow the Lord." But now as part of the Student Union Worship Band I've put that out there.

Now Jesus is my Lord, my Father, my Savior, my redeemer—it's like so much more!


